## FELLOWSHIPS

EPHAR intends to award 5 fellowships of Euro 1000,00 each in order to help young scientists to cover the expenses for the participation in the summer school.

### Eligibility

Applicants must be not older than 35 years. They must be PhD students in Pharmacology, Neuroscience or related sciences, or they must hold a doctorate degree or equivalent. The applicants must be citizens of one of the member countries of the European Federation of Pharmacological Societies (EPHAR).

### Applications

The application must be sent by e-mail (as attachment) AND by priority mail to: Prof. Filippo Drago, Member of the Executive Committee of the EPHAR, Department of Experimental and Clinical Pharmacology, University of Catania, Viale Andrea Doria 6 95125, Catania, Italy, (fdrago@tin.it) before July 1, 2010. The applications must include a short CV, the list of publications, and a recommendation letter written by the supervisor or by the head of the laboratory in which the applicant works.

### Selection

The selection will be made by a Committee formed by the President and a member of the Executive Committee of the EPHAR, and by a member of the Scientific Advisory Board of the International Summer School. In the selection a geographical criterion (applicants from as many EPHAR member countries as possible) will be considered. The candidates who have been awarded the fellowship will be informed by July 4, 2010.
